- Each camp has a before and/or after camp child care option for a small additional cost to allow for early drop off or late pick up of your child to and from camp to help work around busy schedules. These options must be selected during registration.
- Each camp shows a registration deadline and a participation limit. Once the maximum limit of campers is reached, registration will be closed and a waiting list will be started, even if it is before the set registration deadline.
- All cutoff ages are set by the date the camp is being held. For example, if the minimum age for a camp is 4, your participant must be 4 by the first day of that camp.
