



Memorial Tree Program

The Memorial Tree Program is a unique way to honor the memory of a loved one. A memorial tree can be established by requesting a tree be planted in a park with a mutual decision on placement and species. The cost to donate a memorial tree is \$150 (\$100 without a memorial brick). The Parks Department will order and plant the tree, as well as order and install a brick with an inscription designated by the donor. Planting will occur in spring and fall.
