Clinton County is one of about 3,141 counties and county equivalents in the United States. It has 474.2 sq. miles in land area and a population density of 76.7 per square mile. In the last three decades of the 1900s its population grew by 25.5%. On the 2000 census form, 99.5% of the population reported only one race, with 3.9% of these reporting African-American. The population of this county is 1.6% Hispanic (of any race). The average household size is 2.60 persons compared to an average family size of 3.10 persons.

In 2009 health care and social assistance was the largest of 20 major sectors. It had an average wage per job of \$27,306. Per capita income grew by 16.0% between 1998 and 2008 (adjusted for inflation).
