DEPARTMENT: Parks Department JOB TITLE: Maintenance Worker

General Duties:

Performs under the supervision of the Maintenance Supervisor, Park Director, City Administrator, and the Mayor.

Specific Duties:

- Report to work at scheduled time
- Full-time work is not guaranteed; work will be performed on an as-needed basis
- Cutting and weed eating grass at all city locations.
- Maintains all city park grounds i.e. bathrooms, ball diamonds, and shelters
- Picking up litter on city park grounds and city boat ramp
- Maintaining park equipment i.e. mowers, trimmers, trucks, and other various items
- Put up and tear down Christmas lights and displays for Christmas in Carlyle event
- Cleaning bathrooms and other park facilities
- Preparing shelters for reservations
- Painting various buildings and/or equipment
- Assisting other departments as needed
- Assisting in preparing pool for opening
- Assisting in putting up and taking down lights and other displays for Christmas in Carlyle
- Must follow all safety rules and regulations pertaining to mowing, trimming, and other various tasks
 - Any person operating a city mower must wear a seat belt, proper ear protection, and proper eye protection and hard hat.
 - o Any person operating a city trimmer must wear proper ear and eye protection.

- Other duties assigned by the Parks and Recreation Director or Maintenance Supervisor

Education Requirements:

Requires knowledge, skill, and mental development equivalent to the completion of four (4) years of High School.

Special Requirements:

- Must be at least 16 years old with a valid Illinois Driver's License.
- Requires willingness to work in all kinds of weather conditions, to work alone, to make decisions concerning maintenance, repairs and record keeping.
- Able to withstand hard work and physical labor on a continuous basis.
- Must be physically well and can provide a doctor's certification of physical capabilities
 to perform the prescribed duties outlined in this job description. Re-certification of
 individual's physical capabilities may be required by the employer if it is deemed
 necessary to verify the individual's work capabilities.
- Must be able to pass a preemployment background and drug screening.
- Must be able to lift tools, toolboxes, materials, and parts alone weighing up to 100 pounds.
- Physically able to squat, bend, lay, stand, sit, and work during work hours and events.
