COOK-OFF GUIDELINES

This competition is for bragging rights only, it is not a sanctioned contest. The winners are selected by the tasters. So, let's enjoy some soup and have some fun!

1. Setup/Space

- Spaces are 12'x12'
 - O You must provide your own tent/shade, tables, chairs, power cords, etc.
- Teams may begin set up as early as 8am.
- Teams are expected to have their own method for cooking their soup and keeping it at a proper temperature until consumption.
- Any open flame methods of cooking must always be monitored.
- Themed teams and booths are highly encouraged. Please have your team's name proudly displayed in your booth. Prize awarded to favorite booth theme.

2. Soup

- Each team is expected to make a minimum of 10 gallons of soup there is no max.
- There are no limitations on ingredients it is up to you to decide what is "soup."
- You may use any garnish you wish (onions, crackers, cheese, etc.)
- Teams are expected to distribute their own soup and it must be ready to serve at 11:30am.
- A 2-oz Serving Ladle, Bowls, Spoons, and Napkins WILL BE PROVIDED by the City.

3. Tasting Competition

- Tasting wrist bands will be sold for \$10. Tasting will take place from 11:30am 2:30pm.
- There will be no limit set on tastings. Tasters get as much as they want for the wristband.
- Teams have the right to refuse to offer tastings to anyone for any reason.
- The Bragging Rights Winners will be selected by the tasters, via voting tickets.
 - Teams are responsible for collecting votes from the tasters.
 - Voting containers will be provided.
- The voting containers will be collected beginning at 2:30pm.
 - Winners will be announced around 3pm.
- Winning teams will be recognized on the City of Carlyle Facebook page.

4. Winners/Prizes
