This program will be available for eligible\* applicants who are constructing new Single-Family and Two-Family Residences within the corporate limits of the City of Carlyle. Eligible applicants will receive tap-on fee waivers for applicable water, sewer, and electric utilities through the City. Up to \$2,000 in waivers may be approved. Applicants for the Utility Tap Waiver Program must be issued a Certificate of Zoning Compliance prior to this application being approved.
